- Assistive Technology Advocacy Centers (ATAC) purpose is to assist individuals in overcoming barriers in the system and making assistive technology more accessible to individuals with disabilities throughout the state.
- When necessary, ATAC can provide advocacy services and legal representation for individuals with disabilities who are denied access to assistive technology devices and/or assistive technology services.
- ATAC supports a used equipment recycling program called Back In Action. Its mission is to provide an alternative source for assistive technology devices. Back In Action acts as a clearinghouse for items that are for sale or offered for donation or loan.
