

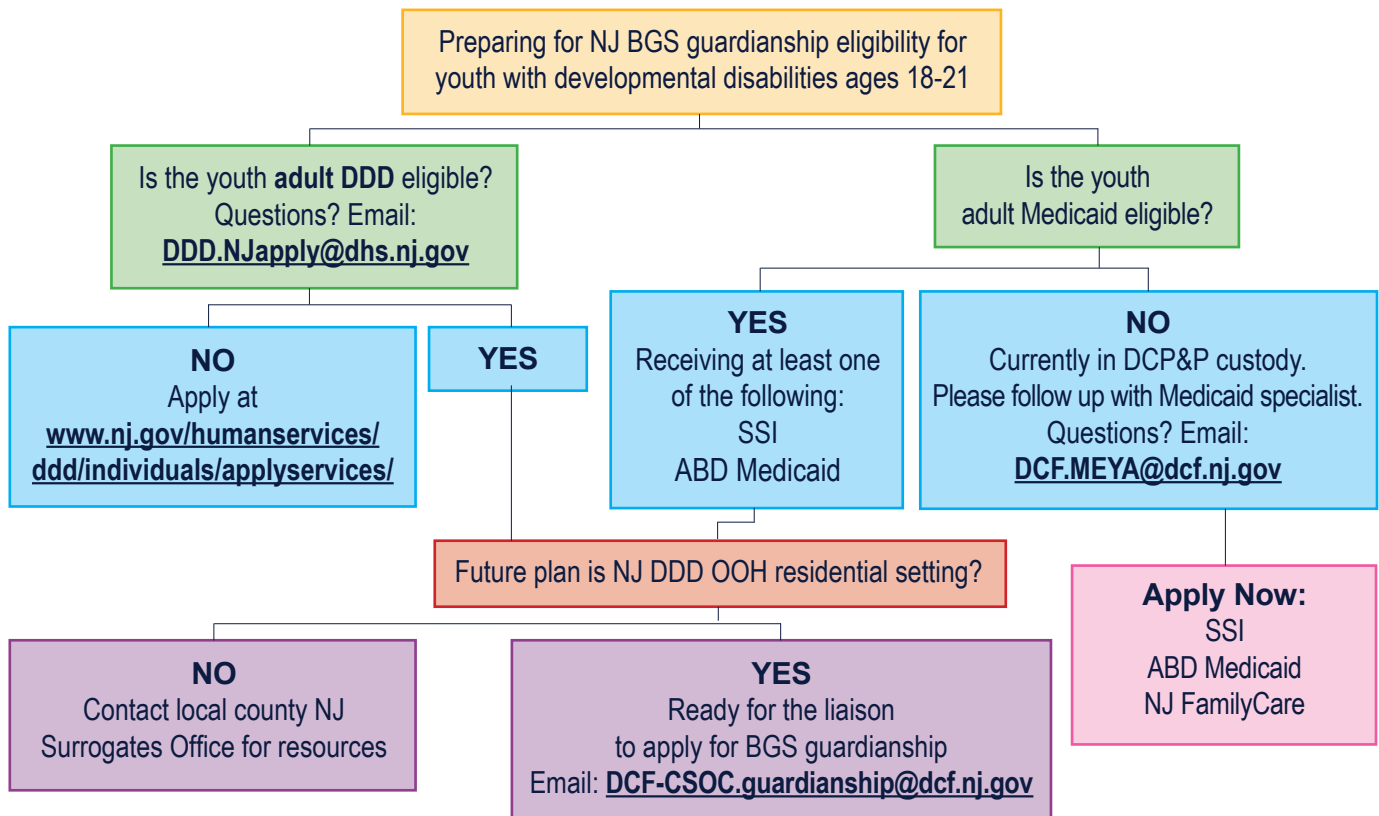
Guardianship for DD Youth Ages 18-21



DCF CSOC Guardianship Liaison responds to inquiries and assists staff in applying for Bureau of Guardianship Services (BGS) for youth who have developmental disabilities and receiving services at DCP&P and/or CSOC. The priority BGS process takes 11-12 months to be appointed a NJ State guardian.

In order to apply for BGS guardianship, the youth must:

- Be Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) eligible
- Be Adult Medicaid eligible
- Have a plan to reside in a NJ DDD setting such as a nursing home, hospital setting, group home, supervised living arrangement, etc.
- Limited or no natural family supports involved with youth
