This transitional post-secondary program is a collaboration between The Arc of Somerset County, Raritan Valley Community College, and The Arc of Hunterdon County.
- The goal of the three year program is to provide students with intellectual and developmental disabilities the opportunity to participate in a college experience on the RVCC campus while receiving additional support to maximize success.
- The admission process is comprised of a formal application and an interview. The Achievement Center program is not limited to residents of Somerset County and Hunterdon County.
- Students wanting to be considered for this program must present a documented disability that is characterized by significant limitations both in intellectual functioning and in adaptive behavior.
