Special Child Health Services Case Management



- Each of NJ's 21 counties maintains a Special Child Health Services (SCHS) Case Management Unit (CMU).
- This service is free to access for families that have a child with special health needs, including children with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
- All SCHS CMU Case Managers, work with the child's parents, physician, and/or specialists to evaluate an affected child's strengths and needs; and collaborates with community-based partners to develop and individual service plan (ISP) for the child and family.
- The goal of SCHS CMUs is to provide comprehensive, coordinated, culturally competent case management services to families with CYSHCN.
