## 5 Programs of The Arc of New Jersey



- Criminal Justice Advocacy Program helps the courts and corrections systems work more effectively with people with developmental disabilities and find alternatives to incarceration.
- Planning For Adult Life assists young adults 16-21 and their families to plan for their adult life.
- Mainstreaming Medical Care helps families navigate the Medicaid and Medicare systems, while training health care professionals about the health care needs of people with disabilities.
- Project HIRE assists adults with disabilities in finding and maintaining competitive employment. The program also assists Middle and High School students in their transition to adult life with its School-to-Work program.
- The New Jersey Self-Advocacy Project supports New Jersey's 110 self-advocacy groups for individuals with developmental disabilities.
