Non-Driver Identification Card



- Starting at age 14, New Jersey residents, regardless of disability, can apply for a non-driver photo identification card.
- An ID card in New Jersey is necessary in order to identify yourself to an authority figure such as a police officer.
- In case of emergency, it is always important to carry at least one form of identification, and if your student wants to open a bank account or travel by plane for example, they will need a form of identification.
- Just like a driver's license, a non-driver ID will also expire. Maintaining a valid ID and keeping track of renewal requirements can help build self-help skills, and improves self-determination skills.
- The non-driver ID is issued solely for the purpose of proving identification.
