- All programs are free to eligible athletes, including insurance, facilities, equipment, uniforms, housing and meals.
- In addition to programs offered on the local, county, sectional and state levels, Special Olympics New Jersey offers athletes free participation in all activities at their Sports Complex in Lawrenceville.
