- All FSOs offer a variety of support groups and educational workshops for family members on issues relating to children with intellectual & developmental disabilities, mental health issues and substance abuse disorders.
- The FSO works directly with youth ages 12-21 who have been involved with the mental health, developmental disability, juvenile justice, or child welfare systems. This program entitled "Youth Partnership" provides a forum for youth to share their experiences. The Youth Partnership members are committed to making a difference through community service.
